Details of the event

The objective for this seminar was to encourage entrepreneurship for women. Many female entrepreneurs in India experience difficulties in obtaining traditional bank loans since they might not have the proof or ownership of property required for loan sanctions. The seminar highlighted legal and policy support is crucial for women entrepreneurs. Gender prejudices and discriminatory behaviours should be eliminated in company legislation and taxation. The government has implemented plans to encourage women entrepreneurs, including the Stand-Up India scheme and the Mudra Yojana, but more changes and more enforcement are required.
